Did You Know?

Supplemental Security Income (SSI) is a federal government program that provides monthly benefits to adults and children with disabilities, and needy adults over the age of 65. When a child is eligible for SSI under this program the Cabinet, as representative payee, receives a monthly SSI payment on behalf of the child. The Cabinet can draw against these funds to cover the cost of the child's daily care and maintenance.

The Cabinet has contracted with Public Consulting Group, Inc (PCG) to identify all children who are currently in foster care and in the care/custody of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, who may be eligible for Supplemental Security Income (SSI) benefits from the Social Security Administration (SSA).
