Did You Know?

That CHFS has a memorandum of understanding (MOU) with the Commission for Children with Special Health Care Needs (CCSHCN) that enables children in foster care to receive certain audiology services?

Those who may qualify for these services are:

- Children entering foster care with diagnosed hearing loss, who need continued monitoring and hearing aid checks; and
- Babies entering foster care who failed their newborn hearing screening, or have risk factors for progressive or delayed hearing loss:
 - The Nurse Consultant Investigator (NCI) for each region can assist the worker in accessing the newborn screening reports.
