The intent of this correspondence is to provide guidance on new, required training for PCC's and PCP's.

<u>Human Trafficking 101: An Overview</u> is a mandatory training for all PCC employees and all PCP employees. The training will ensure that employees understand the federal law relating to human trafficking, understand the types of human trafficking, know the risk and protective factors for human trafficking and to be able to locate and access resources for survivors and youth at risk of human trafficking.

This training should be completed by all exiting staff by September 30, 2022 and within 90 days of hire for new staff.

This training is highly recommended for foster parents of survivors and at-risk youth. Foster parents should access this training at http://centervideo.forest.usf.edu/jit/ky/humtrafficking101/start.html

<u>Screening and Identification of Human Trafficking</u> is a mandatory training for all clinical and direct care PCC and PCP staff. This training will assist staff to focus on the elements of control, increase knowledge of vulnerabilities and red flags specific to human trafficking, become familiar with screening tools and techniques for human trafficking identification, and expand understanding of integrating screening into intake and assessment processes and response to screening outcomes.

This training should be completed by all existing clinical and direct care PCC and PCP staff by September 30, 2022 and will be repeated biannually. New employees should complete the training within 90 days of hire.

DCBS staff are required to take the same trainings to ensure consistency in practice across the continuum.
