## Did You Know?

## **No Attestation Required**

Federal law permits hospitals to disclose relevant health records to government agencies, such as DCBS (Department for Community Based Services), when the request involves child abuse or neglect investigations.

- Under 45 CFR § 164.512(b)(1)(ii), such disclosures are explicitly allowed
- These requests do not require attestation or special authorization from DCBS
- Under <u>45 CFR § 164.509(a)(1)</u>, restrictions apply to records related to reproductive health care in very specific cases not child protection matters

When records are requested by DCBS for a child abuse or neglect investigation:

- Release the records as permitted by law
- Do not request an attestation. Refer to 45 CFR § 164.512(b)(1)(ii) and 45 CFR § 164.509(a)(1) for additional information.
