



Did You Know?

The Interested Party Review (IPR) request for information (RFI) is automated in TWIST.

When a child is placed in out-of-home care, the Citizen Foster Care Review Board (CFCRB) requests information from the case manager to conduct an Interested Party Review (IPR).

The case manager will receive a request for information (RFI) in TWIST, when the IPR is due.

The IPR utilizes the same information that the local CFCRB uses for case reviews, such as the current case plan, current service recordings, ongoing assessment, and placement log. Submitting all information on the RFI timely ensures timely and accurate IPRs and reduces case manager time and emails with CFCRB staff.
