Youth Exit Survey

- The purpose of the Youth Exit Survey is to garner vital information on the outcomes and perspectives of youth aging out in order to improve the services and supports provided to transition age foster youth.
- The Youth Exit Survey is for youth 18 and over leaving state's care.
- The social worker should ensure the youth has completed a Youth Exit Survey or complete it on their behalf, prior to exiting the youth from care.
- Youth who complete the Youth Exit Survey will receive a \$100 Visa gift card.
- The Youth Exit Survey can be completed at KYRISE Youth Exit Survey or through the KYRISE mobile app.
