Need some training on Human Trafficking?

With the passage of Human Trafficking Legislation in Kentucky in 2013, DPP now investigates allegations of human trafficking whether or not the alleged perpetrator is a caretaker. As a result, understanding the dynamics in human trafficking cases is important and will help you recognize signs of human trafficking as well as the best way to interview and intervene with victims.

There are some options available to you to get this training:

- A web-based training has been developed for all staff on Human Trafficking and it is mandatory. Participants will receive .50 credit hours upon completion. https://training.eku.edu/HumanTraffickingWBT
