As part of the Program Improvement Plan (PIP 1A.5.6), The Coordinating Services for Children workgroup has designed a tool for supervisors to use to coach and mentor front line social workers around the themes and items of the PIP called “Did you know”.

The purpose of “Did you know” is to strengthen and reinforce the agency’s policies, procedures, and philosophy. “Did you know” will be e-mailed weekly to staff and will cover a variety of topics from expectations regarding sibling visits to highlighting available resources. Although all staff will receive this information, we are requesting that supervisors and management staff review this information during staff meetings, case consultations, and individual coaching and mentoring.
