NONTRADITIONAL PLACEMENTS UTILIZATION AND DEFINITIONS

Non-traditional placements (NTP) are short-term care solutions for children in out-of-home care (OOHC) for whom a current placement search has not identified any placement options. NTP are **not** long-term options, and the placement search should continue with urgency when a child is in NTP.

DEFINITIONS				
Hospital boarding (not admitted)	Hospital boarding refers to health facilities holding patients, typically in the emergency department (ED), while awaiting an inpatient bed.			
Interim caregiver	Short-term care provided by an approved respite provider to a child in OOHC for whom a current placement search has not identified any placement options. To be considered a last resort option to prevent a child sleeping in an office setting while the search for appropriate placement continues with urgency.			
Approved respite provider	A caregiver who has met requirements specified in Section 17 of <u>922 KAR 1:350</u>			
Respite care	Temporary care provided by a caregiver who has met requirements specified in Section 17 of 922 KAR 1:350 for the purpose of meeting the needs of the child or providing relief to the foster or adoptive parents with the expectation of a child's return to the current foster or adoptive home. Respite care provided out of the child's foster home is considered a temporary living condition not to exceed two (2) weeks.

- Non-traditional placement is a last resort option that should only be used when all other options are exhausted. The search for appropriate placement should continue with urgency until a traditional placement is identified.
- If the placement qualifies as another placement type (relative, fictive kin, foster parent, education, other, self) then it is not NTP and should not be documented as such.
- Notify the regional high acuity specialist immediately if a youth enters NTP.


