SUBJECT: Revisions to SOP 12.3, SOP 12.5, SOP 12.6, and SOP 12.7

The purpose of this transmittal letter is to inform staff of the following revisions to standards of practice:

SOP 12.3 Foster and Adoptive Home Applicant Assessment and SOP 12.5 Pre-Service Training Requirements for Foster and Adoptive Parent Applicants clarification is added that a minimum of one (1) meeting will be in the home of the applicant and the other two (2) meetings will be either in the home or by videoconference, and at the discretion of the supervisor.

<u>SOP 12.6 Foster and Adoptive Home Parents Approved by Other States or Licensed Child Placing Agencies</u> the following language is added: The R&C worker assess during the in-home interview the applicant's home environment and prerequisites as outlined in <u>SOP 12.13 Home Environment Prerequisites</u>.

The above SOP revisions were sent for field draft review; however, no statement of consideration is needed.
