

## Statement of Consideration (SOC)

PPTL 23-16 SOP 4.13, SOP 4.28.4, and SOP 4.29.2 The following comments were received in response to SOP drafts sent for field review. Thanks to those who reviewed and commented. Comments about typographical and grammatical errors are excluded; these errors have been corrected as appropriate.

### **SOP 4.13**

1. **Comment:** Staff do not think that children entering the military should remain in DCBS custody.

**Response:** The Cabinet for Health and Family Services (CHFS/Cabinet) wants to support young people who enter the military. By allowing youth to remain in custody, the Cabinet can provide ongoing emotional support for youth that may not have other available options. In addition, the Cabinet strives to eliminate barriers for youth when they complete training by providing assistance should they need housing or other supports upon completion if the youth remains eligible to receive extended commitment services.
