- 1. Comment:** In the Introduction, where it speaks about what an ongoing assessment should include, perhaps adding that face-to-face contact with the child should be private if possible would be helpful.

**Response:** Language has been changed to reflect this comment. ~~This assessment includes face to face contact with the parent, face to face contact with the child, contact with service providers, contact with caregivers, and other collateral contacts.~~ **This assessment includes information related to the ongoing contact with the family in accordance with C7.21 SSW's Ongoing Contact with the Child and Family, Including the Medically Complex Child.**

### **SOP C7.30**

- 1. Comment:** The Prevention Plan should also include the PCP agency as they will still be providing services during this time period. This should also be entered on the TLC screen with the prevention plan attachment. The placement change to Trial Home Visit should only occur at the end of the 14-day Extended Visitation agreement.

**Response:** Additional language has been added to support this comment.
