

Did You Know?

The PCP/PCC is to provide a two (2) week paid "bed hold" for children needing medical/psychiatric hospitalization or AWOL, assuring the child can return to the same facility/foster homes during that period of time. Paid bed holds are not applicable when a PCP/PCC transfers a child between its own programs (i.e., facility and/or foster homes).

If during the bed hold period the PCP/PCC determines that it cannot meet the needs of the child and does not wish for the child to return to the same facility/foster homes, the PCP/PCC must provide written notice to the Cabinet. The date of the notice will be considered the discharge date, and this notice negates any obligation of the Cabinet for payment of any bed hold days.

If for any reason, the Cabinet determines at any time during the approved bed hold period that the child will not return to the same facility/foster home placement, the SSW must provide written notice to the PCP/PCC, and the bed hold days will be paid only up to the date of the notice to the PCP/PCC. The date of the Cabinet's notice to the PCP/PCC will be considered the discharge date.
