

# Did You Know?

Relatives may be eligible for KTAP, food stamps or a medical card when they are caring for children as part of a prevention plan not just when they have temporary custody? It is important for the SSW at the time placement occurs to refer relatives to Family Support, while also discussing that kinship care benefits (get the KC-01 signed) may be an option if a substantiation occurs and other criteria are met. Offering supportive services to relatives quickly promotes placement stability and enhanced well-being for children.
