

# Did You Know?

If a youth leaves Out-of-Home Care on or after their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday or were adopted from Out-of-Home Care on or after their 16<sup>th</sup> birthday, they may be eligible to receive Education Training Voucher (ETV) Funds.

Youth are eligible to receive the ETV funding if they are 18 to 21 years old and are enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at a post-secondary institution or a job training program. If the participants are in good standing at age 21 they may continue the ETV

program  
until age 23.
