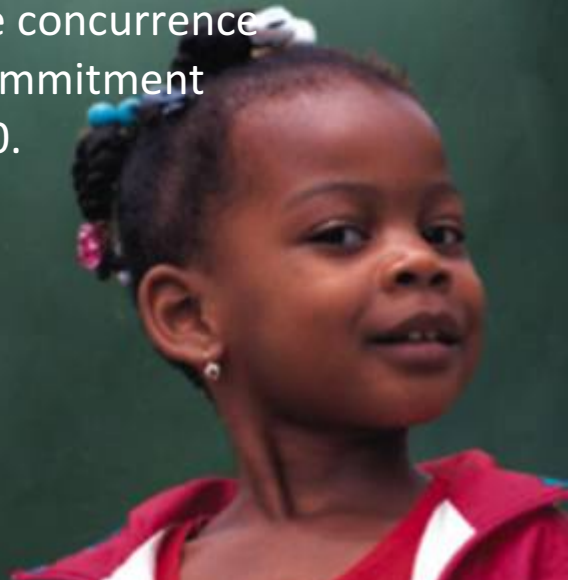

# Did You Know?

## Extending Commitment:

- There are two reasons a child may request to extend commitment with the Cabinet for Health and Family Services.
- Per KRS 625.025 a youth may request transitional living support to participate in a state or federal educational programs or to assist the child in establishing independent living arrangements.
- Upon receipt of the request and with the concurrence of the Cabinet, the court may authorize commitment up to age twenty-one (21) per KRS 620.140.
