

Did You Know?

It is very important for youth to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at www.fafsa.ed.gov as soon as possible after January 1, 2012 as award funds are limited and may be depleted quickly.

Once a foster youth receives their 2011 W-2 and submits their tax form, they can complete the 2012-2013 FAFSA online.

Foster youth planning to attend college for the 2012-2013 will need to complete the FAFSA online.

Foster youth already attending will need to complete the 2012-2013 renewal FAFSA online.

Foster youth should access all financial aid funds available to them prior to requesting tuition assistance through the Cabinet.

Contact your local Independent Living Coordinator with additional questions or assistance in helping foster youth complete the FAFSA.
