

Did You Know?

Approval must be obtained from the Commissioner or designee for all children under sixteen (16) years of age prior to establishment of a Planned Permanent Living Arrangement (PPLA) goal, or for a child of **any** age placed with a private child caring (PCC) or private child placing (PCP) agency.

The DPP-201 PPLA Worksheet and other supporting documents, including a statement from child's therapist/counselor indicating PPLA is in the best interest of the child, must be completed and submitted to the Director's office for review and will then be forwarded to the Commissioner's office.
