

Did You Know?

- The preventive child care SOP was recently revised and includes a new tip sheet: [Preventive Child Care Assistance Tip Sheet](#).
- Preventive requests are intended for situations in which a child is placed with a relative, or at home with a parent, and child care is needed to address a low-risk safety concern to prevent the risk from escalating to a moderate or high level.
- DCC-85 forms are signed by the FSOS and submitted to the local CCAP agent.
- Under limited circumstances, the SRA can approve a DCC-85 if there is an extreme need for child care services. For example, the transition of a child from foster care to a relative's home, and the relative needs some time to arrange child care on their own.
