

Did You Know?

If a child is diagnosed with mental retardation or a developmental disability (Physical), the child should be placed on the Supports for Community Living (SCL) waiting List at the earliest age possible. The social services worker must complete the Supports for Community Living application (MAP-620) and submit it along with a psychological assessment including IQ score, and a adaptive assessment to:

The social services worker will receive a yearly letter confirming the need for the youth to remain on the SCL waiting list. If for some reason this letter is not received, the social services worker will need to contact Lisa Mullikin at Lisa.Mullikin@ky.gov and ensure the youth remains on the SCL waiting list. At age 20.5 DCBS Central office will submit a letter to Lisa Mullikin to access the SCL slot.
